### **Electrical Technician**

Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, the successful candidate maintains, overhauls and troubleshoots, electrical, electromechanical, electronic, pneumatic and computerized systems for diesel Engines, Boilers, Incinerators, Steam and Gas Turbines, auxiliary equipment, renewable generating units and battery storage devices.

#### **In this role the successful candidate will be required to:**

- Inspect and maintain electrical, electronic and instrumentation equipment on generating units(including renewable generating units and battery storage devices) and auxiliary systems
- Troubleshoot and repair faults on all electrical, electromechanical, electronic and pneumatic and computerized systems on generating units (including renewable generating units and battery storage devices) and auxiliary systems
- Install, test and assist in commissioning new equipment including control systems, electrical/electronic equipment and instrumentation
- Clean, inspect and service generator alternators and motors
- Clean, test and inspect transformers
- Sample and filter transformer oil
- Maintain high voltage generator breakers, motors and motor control switchgear, batteries and battery charging equipment, transformers and tap changers
- Maintain lighting and electrical communication systems
- Troubleshoot and maintain fire and security systems
- Observe all safety rules and regulations in accordance with the Generation Permit to Work System and other company policies
- Maintain a safe and clean work environment in accordance with company policy and Procedures

#### **Qualifications and Experience**

- Completion of the Ordinary Technician's Diploma (OTD) or an Associate Degree in Electrical Engineering, City and Guilds Parts 1 and 2 in Electrical Maintenance or an equivalent technical qualification
- Four (4) years of practical on-the-job experience is required for acceptable proficiency
